

FAQ's about Botox® Cosmetic

What is Botox® Cosmetic? A protein placed specifically in the muscles of the forehead or crow's feet around the eyes used to selectively decrease muscle function and prevent the formation of wrinkling and deep lines. Botox® Cosmetic improves the appearance and decreases the prominence of existing frown lines, forehead furrows or crow's feet. Injections are usually repeated every three to four months to maintain results.

Why might I consider Botox® Cosmetic? Looking younger and improving facial appearance often may be attained through non-surgical solutions such as using Botox or in conjunction with facial surgery or other procedures and skin care. Decreasing animation and frown lines can make you look less tired and angry creating a more fresh and bright look.

- Results are not permanent and will need to be re-injected every 3 to 6 months to maintain results
- Common side effects are minimal bruising and numbness but are minimal and short in duration
